Year group	Topics and Key Learning Points
Year 7	School: saying what is in your classroom and school bag; school subjects; the time; describing the school day. Free Time: giving opinions on sports and musical instruments; hobbies. Life at Home: describing the house where you live. Food: giving opinions about food; ordering food. Easter in Germany. <b>(Writing, Reading, Speaking, Listening)</b>

Year 7	Name the places in a town; saying what you can do in a particular place; directions; learning to buy tickets and presents; understanding tourist information. Year 9	Music, cinema and TV: talking about music, cinema and TV; food and drink in German; sport activities; extreme sport. <b>(Writing, Reading, Speaking, Listening)</b>
